Prayer Emphasis

Retreat with God

Pray for missionaries to take personal prayer retreats to get their direction from God.

Eyes to See Like Jesus

Ask God to give missionaries eyes to see as He sees and empower them to love the unlovely, the rejected and the outcast as Jesus did.

"Man does not see what the Lord sees, for man sees what is visible, but the Lord sees the heart." (1 Samuel 16:7b)

Sacrifice of Holy Living

Ask God to empower missionaries to be healthy in mind, body and spirit.

"...I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind..." (Romans 12:1-2)

Prayer Emphasis

Focus on God

Pray for missionaries to stay focused on God and His plans above all else.
“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all things will be provided for you.” (Matthew 6:33)

Confession and Repentance

Pray for missionaries to regularly seek examination by God and to repent from any errors that have crept into their lives.
“Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns. See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way.” (Psalm 139:23-24)

Humility

Pray for missionaries to have a spirit of humility and to willingly ask God for wisdom in carrying out their assignment.
“Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives to all generously and without criticizing, and it will be given to him.” (James 1:5)

Boldness

Pray for boldness in the missionaries when they share the gospel or preach.
“Pray also for me, that the message may be given to me when I open my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel.” (Ephesians 6:19)

Guard and Treasure

Pray for missionaries to stay focused on the gospel of Jesus Christ and not be distracted by issues of the day.
“Hold on to the pattern of sound teaching that you have heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. Guard, through the Holy Spirit who lives in us, that good thing entrusted to you.” (2 Timothy 1:13-14)

Give Glory to God

Ask God to empower missionaries to point people to Jesus and not seek undue recognition for themselves.
“In the same way, let your light shine before men, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.” (Matthew 5:16)

Dependence on God

Pray for missionaries to model a life of dependence on God.
“Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not rely on your own understanding; think about Him in all your ways, and He will guide you on the right paths.” (Proverbs 3:5-6)

GIVE

As you give generously and sacrificially through the Cooperative Program, Lottie Moon, and Annie Armstrong you allow more than 5,800 of your fellow Southern Baptist to concentrate on sharing Christ's love with people who don't know Him.

Yet thousands of people groups continue to live in spiritual darkness, and no one is planting churches among them. Closing this gap will require an unprecedented missionary focus partnering with churches like ours. God has provided the resources. Will you be found faithful?

GO

People from all walks of life have the skills and abilities needed to share the gospel with those who have not yet found a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Teachers, pastors, lawyers, agriculturists, bookkeepers, homemakers, carpenters and others are being used by God to take His message to the world. You may be some of the workers He's looking for.

Anyone who is physically fit to travel can share the love of Christ. Opportunities range from a few days to a year.

Families with young children can participate in short mission trips that provide opportunities for each family member to be involved. There are also local mission opportunities for our families with small children to participate. These can range from assisting in local shelters to state opportunities.

Teams of students, 15 years or older or who have completed the ninth grade, may apply for mission projects through various avenues such as International World Changers. Opportunities are also available for individual students as well.

College, seminary students and adults can serve overseas as well as stateside assignments ranging from one week to a year. These assignments cover a wide range of gifts and skills and are available in the United States and more than 100 countries.

Cathy Palmer, a Mission Service Corps missionary and Director of the Refugee Sewing Society, had a calling from God in 2006 to work with refugees. As a result, in November 2008 Cathy began a small sewing class at the Clarkston Community Center. Today, refugee women from Somalia, Bhutan, Sudan, Iraq, Burundi, and other countries work at the nonprofit entity. The women make market bags and their specialty refugee bags. They take orders for doll clothing, jewelry bags, tote bags for women's conferences, and other products. Many of the women are providing the only income for their family. "A part of our ministry is helping the women heal from trauma and recover their self-esteem", Cathy said. "Leaders with the sewing society work hard to build strong relationships with the women. We provide teatime each day so our women can gather and share stories from the past and help each other learn to cope with life in America."

We began our mission assignment in Taipei, Taiwan. Ron was the treasurer for the Taiwan Baptist Mission. Main responsibilities were disbursement of needed funds to the field missionaries and accountability for how the funds were used. Linda worked with a small group of professional women who had studied English and were eager to grow in their faith in Christ. She also worked in an orphanage for HIV babies.

As a couple, we led a weekly Bible study in our apartment for English speakers while we studied Mandarin. Unexpectedly, the IMB combined several financial offices and we were transferred to Chiang Mai, Thailand. Ron again served in a support role to get needed funds to missionaries in East Asia. Linda worked to encourage missionary wives who lived in Chiang Mai and those who came from areas with poor medical care to deliver their babies in the Chiang Mai hospital.
